

## Guilford Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes February 18, 2016

### Town Meeting plans:

Linda Lembke has arranged for a table with Troy Revis. The plan is to post maps and identify significant biological sites on the map. Forms will be provided to encourage Guilford residents to share other places of natural interest.

On motion it was voted to forgo the regular GCC meeting and attend the regional meeting in Putney on March 31.

Planning for upcoming workshops concerning conservation easements and current use information has been delayed until April so that we can generate questions and plan for an article in the Gazette.

Wendy Stone attended the meeting as she is now the lead person on the newly appointed Recreation Commission and is learning about the different roles of other town commissions. Linda Lembke passed on the recreation brochure to her that was generated during Guilford's 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary year.

### Weeks Forest Update:

A group of GCC members and David Gessner walked the Weeks Forest trail and chose possible waypoints of natural or cultural interest. Some of these were suggestions from GSC's 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The waypoints were marked with survey tape. Jeff Nugent from the WRC used his GPS to mark them on a map that he will generate. He will be lending the 6<sup>th</sup> graders a "wheel" to measure the distances between waypoints and total length of the trail.

Linda Lembke handed out a list of the waypoints and different members chose one or more to generate written descriptions by March 17<sup>th</sup>.

Susan James reported that the proposed Blanchard Cemetery walk will have to be postponed until it is a lot less icy. The next walk will be chosen at the April meeting.

The next meeting is March 31<sup>st</sup> with other regional commissions in Putney.
